<u>ALL IN BREAKAWAY RULES</u>

THIS EVENT IS OPEN TO WOMEN ONLY. NO AGE LIMITS

ENTRY FEES

You may enter up to 4 times, but you can only enter 2 times on each horse. Entry fee is \$1,495. If you choose to enter twice on the same horse, the second entry will be \$1,095. If you choose to enter on a different horse, that entry will be \$1,195, which includes three nights of stall but does not include a hotel room or jacket. Reminder: All entries must be paid in full by November 1, 2023.

PAYMENT PLAN

A payment plan is available at checkout on the NextGen Rodeo app.

Drawout Deadline - November 1, 2023. If you need to draw out call NextGenRodeo at 903-287-7852 or email info@ngrodeo.com.

Entries will Close at the discretion of ALL IN Breakaway management. Draws will be posted no later than **December 1, 2023.**

All payments must be made by credit or debit card. Check Payments will NOT be accepted.

ENTRY FEE INCLUDES

- Entry into the ALL IN Breakaway Roping which includes 2 Long Rounds plus Showdown Round based on roping format detailed below.
- One 10x10 stall for 3 days for one horse including one bag of shavings.

ROPING FORMAT

December 10-12, 2023

Round 1: Sunday, December 10, 2023

- Start time- 6PM PST at Orleans Arena, Las Vegas Nevada (Start time subject to change)
 - Contestants rope in draw order beginning with #1.
 - Example- #1 #300
 - Top 6 contestants with clean runs in each 'D' will qualify for the Showdown Round held on Tuesday,
 December 10, 2023 respectively using a Half (1/2)
 Second split.
 - In the result of a tie in 6^{th} place in each 'D', the contestants will each qualify.
 - Top 6 contestants with clean runs per 'D' will be paid out respectively using the Half (1/2) Second Split
 - 1st thru 6th place contestant with clean runs in 1D, 2D and 3D
 - If any place is not filled, they will not be paid out.

Round 2: Monday, December 11, 2023

- Start time- 6PM PST at Orleans Arena, Las Vegas, Nevada (Start time subject to change)
- Contestants rope in reverse draw order beginning with last draw number from previous day to #1.
 - Example- #300 #1
 - Top 6 contestants with clean runs in each 'D' will qualify for the Showdown Round held on Tuesday, December 10, 2023 respectively using a Half (1/2) Second split.

- In the result of a tie in 6th place in each 'D', the contestants will each qualify.
- Top 6 contestants with clean runs per 'D' will be paid out respectively using the Half (1/2) Second Split.
 - 1st thru 6th place contestant with clean runs in 1D, 2D and 3D
 - If any place is not filled, they will not be paid out.

Showdown Round: Tuesday, December 12, 2023

- Start time- 6PM PST at Orleans Arena, Las Vegas, Nevada (Start time subject to change)
- Contestants' back numbers will remain the same in Round 1 and Round 2.
- Top 18 contestants with clean runs from Round 1 and Round 2 'D's will rope in the Showdown Round. Showdown Round is a clean slate and NO TIME carry over from Round 1 or Round 2.
 - Round 1- Top 6 contestant with clean runs from 1D, 2D and 3D qualify
 - Round 2- Top 6 contestant with clean runs from
 1D, 2D and 3D qualify
- 'Ds' will be divided as follows:
 - 1D will be fastest time in Showdown Round to a half (1/2) second split
 - 2D will begin a half (1/2) second off of fastest time in Showdown Round down to the next half (1/2) second.
 - \circ 3D begins a half (1/2) second from where 2D split begins.

- Champion in each 'D' respectfully will be the contestant with the fastest time based off of a half (1/2) second split set by fastest time in Showdown Round.
- Contestants will receive each qualification they receive from Round 1 and Round 2.
 - Example: Roper #43 places in Round 1 2D in 4th place. She places in Round 2 in 3D in 6th. Both placements carry into the Showdown Round.
 - If a contestant has 2 (two) entries, they can qualify up to 4 (four) times for the Showdown Round.
 - Contestants with 1 (one) entry can qualify up to 2
 (two) times for the Showdown Round.

SIDE POTS

ADULT & SENIOR INCENTIVE

- \$50 entry fee
- Adult Side pot will be open to Contestant's 19-54 years old as of Jan 1, 2023.
- Senior Side Pot is open to contestants 55 years of age and older. Age as of Jan. 1, 2023.
- Side pot will be 85% payback.
- Winner of the side pot will be from the average of 2 heads.

YOUTH BREAKAWAY CHAMPIONSHIP

- \$100 Entry Fee
- Youth Breakaway Championship open to contestants 18 years of age and younger. Age as of Jan. 1, 2023.

- A copy of the contestant's birth certificate needs to be sent to info@lvbreakaway.com before November
 5, 2023.
- The Youth Breakaway Championship will be selected based on average time on two-head from Round 1 and Round 2.
- If a contestant has multiple entries in the ALL IN Breakaway Roping and one Youth Breakaway Championship entry, contestant's "A" draw will be used for the Youth Breakaway Championship.
- Contestants may enter the Youth Breakaway Championship up to two (2) times, IF contestants have two (2) entries in ALL IN Breakaway Roping.
- December 10-13, 2023
- 75% Payback
- \$5,000 Added

BUY BACK ROUND - \$7,000 Guaranteed Payout

The Buy Back Round will follow the conclusion of Qualifying Round 2. It is an Open 3D with a \$200 entry fee capped to the first 200 entries.

ENTER ON-SITE - CASH ONLY. The Top 4 in each D will receive Showdown Round positions. The Top 4 in each D will receive a Guaranteed Payout. 1st place will receive \$500, 2nd \$400, 3rd \$300, and 4th \$200. Entries will open at check-in and will close 30 minutes after the conclusion of Qualifying Round 2 if still available. There will be NO REFUNDS for entries into the Buy Back Round and entries are limited. You must compete on the same horse that you entered for the ALL IN Breakaway (You cannot bring in/substitute a horse that was not already entered.) You will not be allowed to sell your entry. Specific horse must be designated at the time of Buy Back Entry.

EVENT RULES

STALL CHECK IN

Sunday, December 10, 2023 at 10am

- Coggins and Health certificates must be presented before placing horse(s) in stall(s).
- NO outside shavings, straw or pellets are allowed as bedding. ALL IN Breakaway Roping provides one bag of shavings with 1st (first) entry. Shavings are sold onsite in the stall lot for \$10 per bag. Cash or credit cards are accepted (credit cards are subject to a 3.5% processing fee/convenience fee).

CONTESTANT CHECK IN

Sunday, December 10, 2023 9am-6pm

- Each contestant must check-in with the office for completing paperwork, taking contestant headshot photos (this is not optional), picking up contestants' jackets (subject to arrival), receiving contestant packets, etc.
 - If you do not attend this check-in, it could result in an automatic draw out.
 - If you are not able to make these times, please contact Taylor at info@lvbreakaway.com.

COGGINS AND HEALTH CERTIFICATE

- Nevada State Livestock has the following requirements:
 - A current Health Certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian issued within 30 days of arrival.
 - A negative Coggins test performed within the previous 6 months of arrival.

Proof of ownership (for example, brand inspection certificate, bill of sale, registration paper); all livestock ENTERING and EXITING the state are required to have a current, valid brand inspection certificate from their state of origin. If your state does not provide brand inspection services, then carry proof of ownership.

ROPING RULES

- Back numbers must be worn during open arena times and in-arena competitive times. Back number is not required when riding in the arena located in the stall lot.
- A rope barrier will be used with a score equaling length of box minus four feet (4'). All score lengths will be subject to Breakaway Directors or Representative approval.
- Two Timekeepers, a Field Judge, a Barrier Judge, and Spotter will be in the arena at all times.
- 3D format with a half (1/2) second splits determines pay-out in all rounds. (Round 1, Round 2 and Showdown Round)
- If any 'D' has openings in the placements for payouts, the money will go into ground money.
- Bell Collar Catch only. Bell collar catch is defined as any loop passing over the calf's head and slack is drawn around the neck only. No other

- appendages of the calf (i.e. front leg, tail, etc.) can be in loop when rope breaks from saddle horn.
- Ropes must be tied to the saddle horn of the contestant's saddle with nylon string at the VERY end of the rope. A bright colored cloth no shorter than six inches (6") must be tied to the end of the rope.
- Any unraveling of nylon strings will result in disqualification.
- Only one (1) loop can be carried. A dropped loop counts as a contestant's thrown loop.
- Rope must be released from contestants' hands to qualify for catch.
- Contestants must pass through the barrier before loop is released.
- Contestants must be on horseback when time is taken.
- Once a calf crosses the score line, it belongs to the contestant. It is at the judges' discretion to give a rerun.
- 30 second time limit. :20 seconds are allowed once contestants enter the box.
- Each contestant needs to follow their calf out of the arena.
- Contestants' calf will be turned out if contestant does not enter the box by third call. This will result in a No Time.
- The Out gate will remain open in the arena at all times. Time must be taken with the calf in the arena. If any part of the calf has entered the out gate, no time will be awarded.
- Breaking the barrier will result in no time.
- The Field Judge will flag the contestant when the rope breaks away from the saddle horn.
- No time will occur if the contestant breaks the rope by hand or touches rope or string after catch is completed.
 - Exception to above, is if rope dallies around the saddle horn. Contestants can ride forward to un-dally and then stop to allow rope to breakaway.
- Entries are limited based on stall availability.
 Entries close when roping reaches capacity.
- Late entries will not be accepted.

- · Round 1 and Round 2 will pay the top 6.
- · In the shoot-out round, only clean catches will qualify for higher money and prizes.
- · If there is left over money in the shoot-out round, it will be paid equally to all ropers with a clean catch.

OTHER GENERAL RULES

DRESS CODE

Full Western Dress code is required during all in-arena times (Round 1, Round 2 and Shoot-out Round). This includes all contestants and companions that are on the arena ground. All contestants are required to wear a long sleeve collared shirt, long pants, western hat or helmet, and cowboy boots. Contestants may wear any and all individual sponsors.

STOCK RULES

- Calves will be on a chute run.
- No stock with horns will be used.

RETURNED CHECKS

- There will be a \$35.00 Service Charge on all returned checks from contestants, no matter what the reasoning.
- o If the check is not replaced with a Cashier's Check, Money Order or Credit/Debit card within 30 days the contestant's entry will be removed and placed on the ineligible list. Note: Credit Cards are subject to 3.5% service fee except for entry fees.

DRAW OUTS

Deadline is November 1, 2023 by 11:59PM CST. Draw out option requires a veterinarian release or doctor release received by AIBK staff by deadline date via email info@ngrodeo.com

- No draw outs allowed after the above deadline is past.
- Option 1: Receive a partial refund.
 - Per entry, AIBK keeps a total of \$300 regardless of the reason for drawing out.
- Alternative options to drawing out:
 - Substitute another horse
 - Sell your entry for an additional fee of \$300. Entries sold must be processed through the NextGenRodeo office. 903-287-7852. New contestant accepts the reservations, stall assignments, draw position, and all additional pre-arranged elements of your entry. Contestants may NOT resell or reallocate their stalls.
- Note: If a contestant is buying a \$1,095 entry from another contestant, but does not already have an entry, then the new contestant is required to pay the difference of \$400 to make this a full entry (each contestant's first entry in each race is \$1495.) Hotel rooms are subject to availability and new contestants preferred room type may not be available.

- After the draw-out deadline of Friday, November 1, 2023, NO refunds will be given for any reason, including partial refunds. You may sell your entry by, December 1, 2023.
- Draw-out refunds will be issued as approved and will be issued to the card you paid your entries with.

SUBSTITUTIONS

Ropers CANNOT be substituted. Horses can be substituted.
 Substituted horses will require a hip number matching contestants' draw number before being competed on. If a substituted horse is not numbered by competition time, this will result in disqualification.

TIE FOR MONIES & PRIZES

- In the result of a tie during any round, the award money will be split equally among the number of ties.
 - O In the result of a tie during any round where a prize is given, a coin flip will determine the winner of the prize. In the event of multiple ties for a prize, a drawing will be held with all contestants' names entered.

PAYOUT REQUIREMENTS

• To receive any winnings, a completed W-9 form must be submitted at check-in or payout will be delayed or forfeited. Based on your country,

documents may be required if you are a non-US citizen. No prizes will be mailed.

FINES

• Any fines incurred must be paid prior to collecting any winnings.

■ Examples of fines: Poor sportsmanship, abusive actions to stock or horse during competition or on premise, damage to stall, etc.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

- O Any act deemed prejudicial to the best interests of ALL IN Breakaway Roping, ALL IN Barrel Race, LLC or Group W Productions, LLC may result in the disqualification of the contestant, with no refund of entry fees. The contestant may also be placed upon the ineligible list for future ALL IN Breakaway Roping events. These acts may include but are not limited to the following:
 - Using abusive or intemperate language or attempting to threaten, bribe, influence, or harass any contestant, spectator, staff member, or arena personnel. Also, any remarks made with the intent to cast aspersions on the character or integrity of a staff or management member.
 - Tampering or attempting to adjust score lines, barrier system, roping box, roping chute, etc.
 - Use of electronic and/or remotely controlled devices to alter the outcome of a run.
 - Abuse of a horse in any way either, on the ground or in the saddle. No whipping a horse from the ground by a bystander.
 - Abuse of an animal in the show arena and/or evidence that an act of abuse has occurred prior to or during the exhibition of a horse in competition.
 - Competing while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
 - Misidentifying a rider in any round of the ALL IN Breakaway Roping competition.
 - Other conduct that is not in the best interest of ALL IN Breakaway Roping, LLC, Group W Productions, LLC, or its contestants.
 - Failure to make good on a returned check to ALL IN Breakaway Roping or to any other association which has a cooperative agreement with ALL IN Breakaway Roping on returned checks.

 ALL IN Breakaway Roping at their sole discretion shall have the authority to disqualify or deny entry to any horse they deem dangerous to the rider, or to other individuals, animals or property.

SAFETY

Safety is a prime objective at this breakaway roping. If you have a horse that could be dangerous to yourself, other contestants, or other horses, DO NOT bring the horse onto the Orleans Hotel & Casino and Orleans Arena premise. Any horse or contestant deemed to be dangerous by the management of ALL IN Breakaway Roping, LLC or Group W Productions, LLC will be disqualified, and entry fees will not be refunded.

DOGS

• No dogs will be allowed on property during the ALL IN Events. This includes trailer parking, RV hook ups, stall lot and inside arena.

SPORTSMANSHIP

• All contestants and their family members are expected to display good sportsmanship at all times. No level of abuse toward any animal at this event will be allowed. Foul language, misconduct, or abusive comments spoken to any contestant, spectator, staff member, or arena personnel will result in immediate contestant disqualification and no refund of entry fees. Contestants are also responsible for traveling companions and their family members.

PHOTOS AND VIDEOS

No commercial photography or videography from the stands unless person(s) has media credentials from ALL IN Breakaway Roping.

ALL IN BREAKAWAY, LLC and its affiliates, Group W Productions, LLC and decisions made by ALL IN BREAKAWAY, LLC management as a result of viewing photos and/or video are final.

By entering you consent to the use of your image and/or likeness of your run and participation for promotion of the ALL IN BREAKAWAY, LLC, and Group W Productions for any and all future use.

VENDORS

O Vendor forms can be requested by emailing info@lvbreakaway.com. Selling any type of merchandise or professional service on the arena grounds, in stalls, or at trailers without a vendor contract with ALL IN Breakaway Roping or Group W Productions is PROHIBITED.

MANAGEMENT RULES

POSTPONEMENT OF EVENT
